CHURCH LAWN MOWING.

Please contact me (708-917-5362) if you want to mow the church lawn.

We would like to have the entire lawn mowed either **Friday or Saturday each week.**

- The chore normally takes from an hour to an hour and 15 minutes.
- The schedule is now filled thru June 5th or 6th.
- Use the **FRONT** (Church Entrance) door to obtain the keys to the garage and mower from the Secretary when she is on duty from 9am to 1pm Monday, Tuesday and Friday.
- Use the **FRONT** (Church Entrance) door to return the keys to the office prior to the following Friday.
- **Two areas** to watch out for are **(1) near the cross** the extension cord to the lights lays coiled up in the grass nearby and **(2) the Pastor's dog chain** is often left lying in the grass near the deck. Just mow around both hazards and leave them lay.
